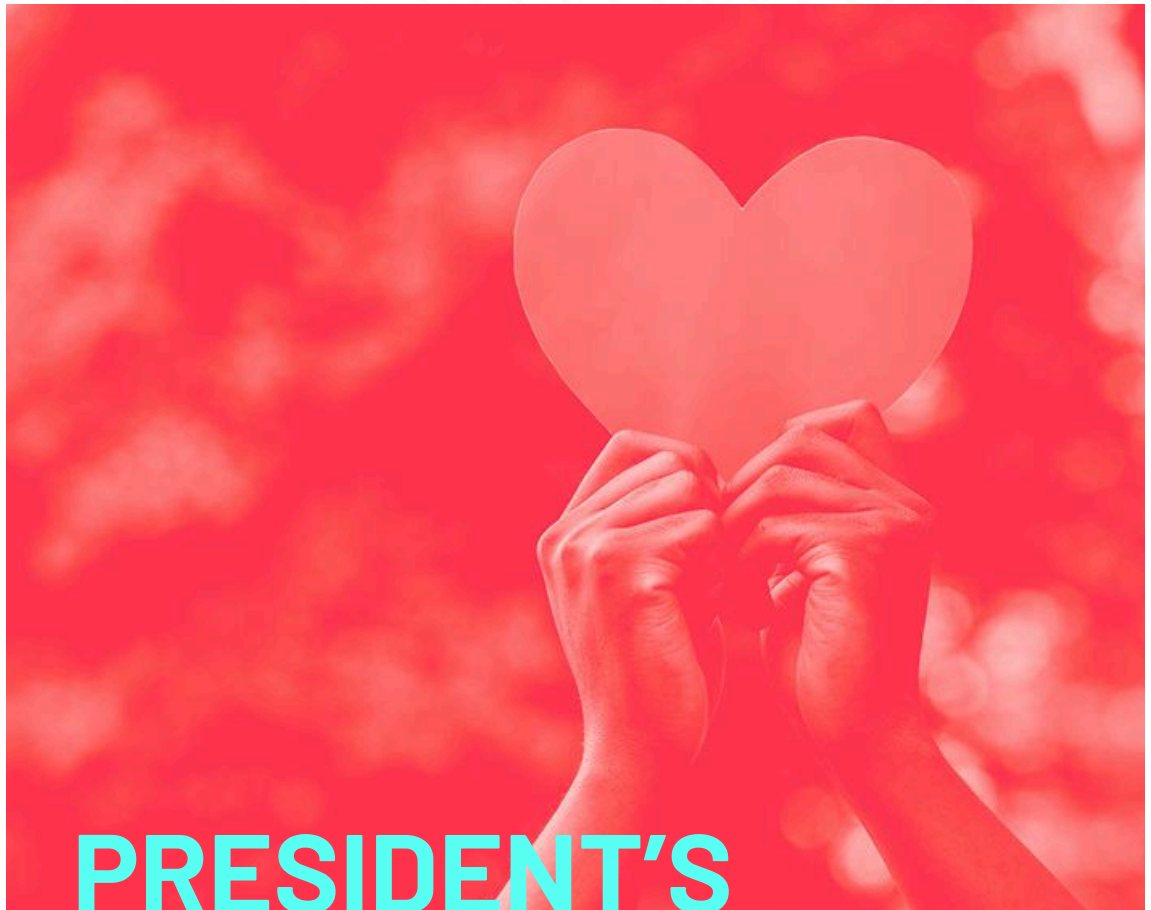

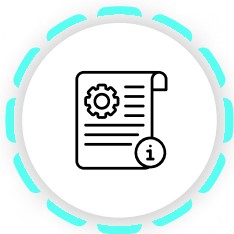
OUR SELECTION PROCESS



PRESELECTION

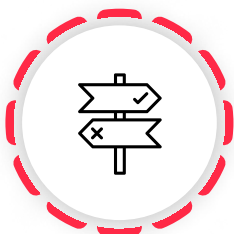
Indosuez Switzerland Foundation launches a call for projects internally and/or externally. Projects can be offered by committed employees or by the associations themselves.

The applications are then received and examined by the Foundation secretary who will verify the alignment of the project with the Foundation's mission as well as the nature of the grant requested.



ANALYSIS

Once shortlisted, the applications are presented to the volunteer employees who make up the consultative committee. The aim is to analyze the files, most often in a pair, and to assess as objectively as possible its impacts and its sustainability.



DECISION

After several weeks of deliberation, the Consultative Committee agrees on the projects to be presented to the Board of Foundation. Each project is presented, the Board of Foundation votes at the end of the meeting for the projects that have come to its attention. These projects will receive funding upon signing a partnership agreement.



LONG TERM SUPPORT

Projects are monitored by employees who have analyzed them in order to ensure that they run smoothly.

THE BOARD OF FOUNDATION (AS OF 31.12.2024)

The Board of Foundation meets twice a year. At the first meeting, it approves the financial statements following the audit carried out by PWC and the budget for the following year. A presentation of ongoing projects is made.

At the second Board meeting, the members of the Consultative Committee come to present potential projects. A vote is taken at the end of the meeting to select projects eligible for funding the following year.

DREAMS
Where Children Rise & Shine

Provide young people with the means to access a better future through support for learning and mastery of reading, writing and numeracy, literacy, communication.



 **Rainbow
Centre**

The non profit organization develops and manages two schemes - vocational training and micro jobs - to increase the employability of people with disabilities. This second part of the project offers young people courses that capitalize on emerging sectors: Social networks and influence marketing to support and provide opportunities aligned with the aspirations and interests of people with disabilities. The expansion of courses in hotel and guidance will also be offered.



MEDAIR

AIDE D'URGENCE ET RECONSTRUCTION

The Medair Project aims to provide drinking water to a Children's Hospital in Kharkiv, Ukraine, which provides care for 241 children in need of specialized medical care. Regular access to drinking water will involve drilling on the hospital's ground, equipped with an electricity supply, a pump and a 1,000 liter storage tank, covered by a reinforced concrete slab.



karuna shechen

This project operates in about 700 villages in India (Bihar, Jharkhand, Darjeeling). It aims to improve the living conditions of the most disadvantaged communities by strengthening sustainable access to water through the construction of 5 wells and 7 ponds, and the planting of 1'500 trees.



association païdos

The 'Atelier des Bricolos' (ADB) is a place of reception in Geneva for children during school and out of school in order to strengthen social diversity, while involving migrant parents in integration. The activities are very diverse and aim at the development of the child and the building of intercultural links.





This project will take place south of Beirut, Lebanon, mobilizing young people around agroforestry. This pilot project will focus on forest management, waste recovery, beekeeping development and the planting of medicinal herbs.



This educational project will take place in Switzerland. In order to improve living well together and self esteem, theatre workshops, as well as training workshops for students and teachers will be organized in the canton of Valais.



The Anak Project supports children aged 7 to 23 from families from the north and north east of Bali, Indonesia, living in extreme poverty to train them until they enter the labour market. Support will focus on extra school activities and the creation of a biological mini farm.

Project aim: increase the employability of young people through the development of 2 training programmes.

SEVEN CLEAN SEAS

 Batam, Indonesia |  1 year

Project purpose: recycle plastic collected in the ocean and convert into tiles to replace asbestos tiles in coastal communities.

ROAD WITHOUT BOARDERS

 Philippines |  1 year



Project purpose: equip an orphanage in Manila with solar panels, computers and water filters Drinking.

MILLE AMIS

 Nepal |  1 year

Purpose of the project: creation of a microcredit cooperative dedicated to women in Nepal to help them become more independent.

IWA KEP

 Cambodia,
Kep Province |  1 year

Project purpose: recover plastic waste by training women in sewing and crochet techniques.
